

Lipizzaner Association of Australasia (LAA)

General Code of Conduct

All LAA Members must meet the following requirements in regard to their conduct and behaviour at all times including any role held within the Association:

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- 2. Respect the Lipizzaner horses owned by others and celebrate in their success as well as your own.
- 3. Be honest in advertising horses for sale or stud. Ensure descriptions and information presented are both reasonable and accurate.
- 4. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealing with others.
- 5. Be professional in, and accept responsibility for, your actions.
- 6. Be responsible for the well being and training of your horses.
- 7. Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adhesion to the LAA Constitution, rules, regulations, by-laws and policies.
- 8. Operate within the rules of the Association including national and international guidelines that govern Lipizzaner breeding, registration and naming conventions.
- 9. Do not use your involvement with the LAA, to promote your own interests, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of the LAA.
- 10. Refrain from any form of harassment of other Members.
- 11. Refrain from any behaviour that may bring the LAA or any affiliated organisations into disrepute.
- 12. Provide a safe environment for the conduct of activities associated with Lipizzaners, Members or the general public.
- 13. Be a positive role model.
