

Part-bred Lipizzaner Standard of Excellence - Judging guidelines

Directives for the Judges of Part Bred Lipizzaner Horse

The most important first trait to be judged is the functionality of the horse and its attributes as an overall performance horse.

Definition of the Outward Appearance

This Lipizzaner Part-bred should be judged as a functional horse not as a breeding animal. The main objective of a part-bred lipizzaner is that of a performance horse.

This being taken into consideration, the horse should be well balanced in appearance with excellent attributes that one would find in a riding & performance horse.

Overall the horse should be correct in all areas of conformation with a desirable temperament. The amount of the Lipizzaner blood in the part-bred will determine the 'more or less' Lipizzaner attributes in the part-bred lipizzaner horse. Lipizzaner part-bred's should not be judged on '*Lipizzaner appearance*' but rather as a whole & on performance attributes.

Movement should be expressive & correct with deviation in movement undesirable (padding/winging)

Part-bred Lipizzaner entires are not permitted into the LAA registry & therefore are not permitted to compete in part-bred lipizzaner classes
